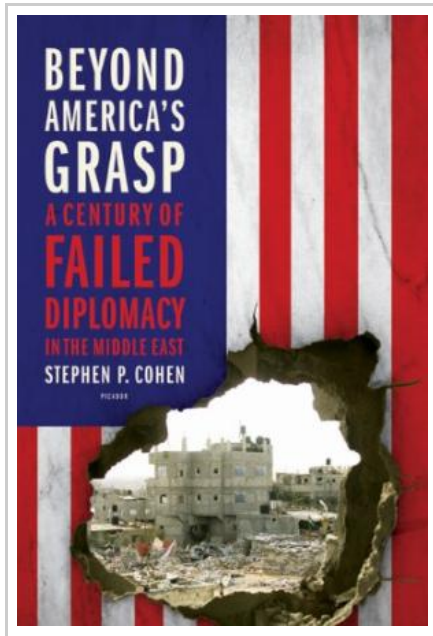




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Beyond America's Grasp: A Century of Failed Diplomacy in the Middle East (Paperback)
