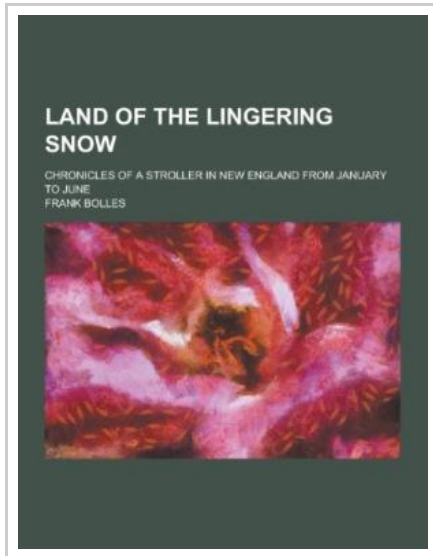




Land of the Linging Snow; Chronicles of a Stroller in New England from January to June (Paperback)
