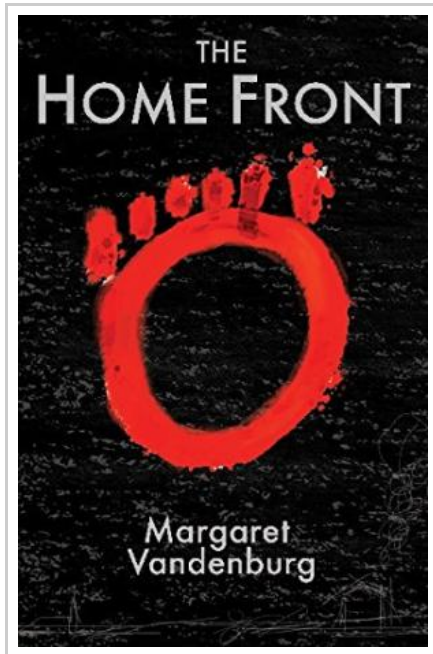




The Home Front (Paperback)
