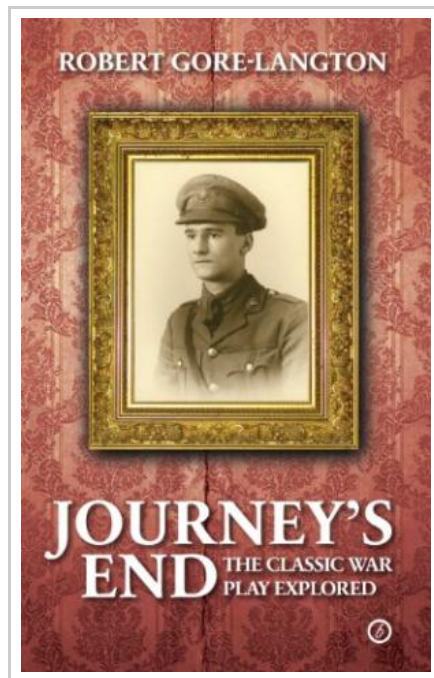




Journey's End: The Classic War Play Explored
