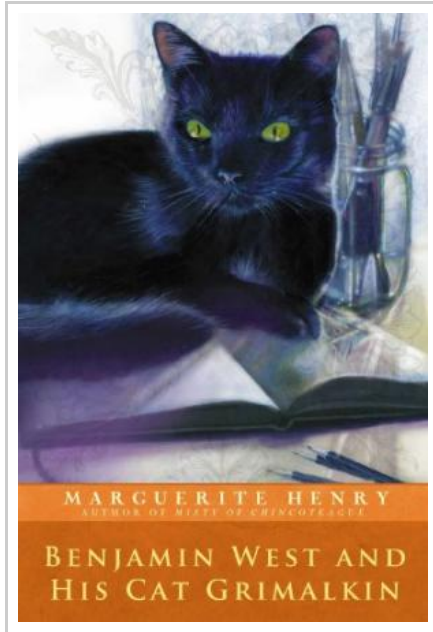




## Benjamin West and His Cat Grimalkin
