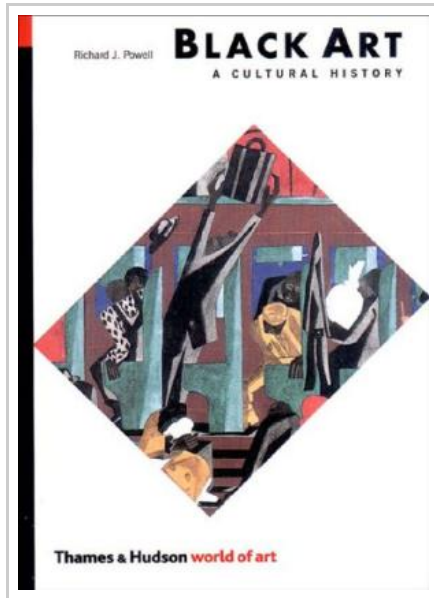




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Black Art: A Cultural History (2nd Revised edition)
